Hello,

My name is Bill Gibson. I serve this area as District Attorney and I live here in Cookeville. Like most people these days I spend some time online and I see all the schemes, scams and rip offs. Occasionally I also find something worthwhile, something worth a second look, and worth passing along.

A couple of weeks ago I heard an advertisement on Magic 98.5 for a company called DealNerd. So I checked it out. They have a concept that made a lot of sense to me and it is totally free to use (now and always). So I joined.

In a nutshell, they are affiliated with and linked to over 300 online stores. They include the big discount stores like Wal-Mart, K-Mart, Blue Light and Target, as well as other quality stores like Brooks Brothers, Eddie Bauer, and J. Crew. I have printed the entire list on the back of this page. You will see there are some pretty interesting specialty shops too.

Once you register you get discounts, deals, and cash-back rebates from the online stores on every purchase. For example 3½% cash-back from Wal-Mart. I bought 3 inkjet cartridges from 1-2-3 inkjets for \$8.00 each and got free shipping, no sales tax and \$3.75 cash back. Those cartridges cost me \$6.75 each. (I had been paying \$23.00 each for the stupid things for years!)

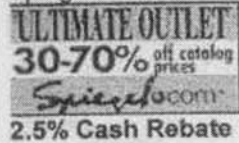
Then when you get others to join you make a smaller commission on their purchases (4% of their rebate amount) for five (5) levels downline. It's not a huge amount of money from any one transaction but 5 levels can produce a very large pool of shoppers.

For example if just 10 people join in your "branch", and each of them gets just 10 people to join and so on for five levels, that's 10x10x10x10x10, or 100,000 members from which you would be drawing a small commission from any online purchases. Every time one of them would get a \$25.00 rebate on their purchases you would get one dollar. So there is certainly some income potential for no investment and basically no work. Some charitable groups are using it for fundraising by just signing on their members and encouraging them to do their shopping there.

This company is young and I expect national membership numbers will grow rapidly. People will join because it is free; it offers a good shopping experience, meaningful savings, plus the opportunity to make some money legally and with little effort. Naturally with the increased buying power of growing membership numbers the deals will get even better. When the deals get better more people downline will shop more and generate more rebate commissions. The rebates and commissions come from the advertising budgets of the affiliated businesses. **No member or customer ever pays anything to use the service.**

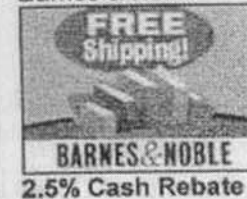


