Rocky: I just need your riding shotgun over the—with the car.

Reno: Right. Okay. Let's see. I wouldn't be able to—I mean--

Rocky: See I don't know what your schedule is, what your days off are, if you can get vacation or whatever you need to do.

Reno: I'm off Wednesday and Thursday, but I can somehow finagle things around. The biggest thing is if I fly down you can't carry a firearm.

Rocky: Oh shit. That's right. Yeah.

Reno: You know I don't know, I would assume that's the main reason—

Rocky: Yeah. Exactly.

Reno: You know what I mean.

Rocky: Why I don't just have Tom and his other buddy do it, right.

Reno: What I could do is—he's leaving on Thursday?

Rocky: I think he said he was leaving Wednesday night to get there Thursday morning. And then we were going to do a couple of days in Daytona and then go down to Miami.

Reno: Okay. Wednesday, which would be the what?

Rocky: ch, ch, ch, March 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Reno: March 3<sup>rd</sup>? Okay. He would leave that night?

Rocky: He would leave that night.

Reno: Who's this other cat, wonder?

Rocky: I have no idea who he is talking about. Personally I would prefer it was just him and you going.

Reno: I don't trust a lot of people.

Rocky: And no I hear you. And this other person ain't going to know shit as far as I'm concerned and don't need to.

Reno: Right. I don't make a lot of friends. And regardless if we are going down there to drink beer I don't like—

Rocky: Yeah, I hear you.

Reno: --I don't like people. Uh, but--

Rocky: But you're right. If you fly—I didn't think about that.

Reno: Yeah, if I flew down it would present a problem as far as that goes.

Rocky: Right.

Reno: But I could probably swing it to where I would just ride down with Tom.

Rocky: Okay.

Reno: And then we would be back Sunday, I guess.

Rocky: Yeah if you left Saturday night or Saturday afternoon or something.

Reno: How many hours is it back up this way? Probably a lot?

Rocky: Goodnight I don't even have a clue.

Reno: So, but, uh, okay. Straight up stuff?

Rocky: What do you mean?

Reno: I mean it ain't no narcotics or anything like that?

Rocky: No, no, no. no.

Reno: Well a man's got to ask, you know what I'm saying?

Rocky: Yeah, yeah. yeah, yeah, no, no, no, no, but it's cash.

Reno: Huh?

Rocky: It's cash.

Reno: Oh okay. Well that's pretty important paperwork.

Rocky: Yeah, that's what I mean. I wouldn't put you--I wouldn't do that to you.

Reno: What does it pay?

Rocky: Uh probably 5 G's for you two to split.

Reno: Okay.

Rocky: However you feel the split should be. However you guys decide to split it. I don't care.

Reno: Let's see, if I'm the heavyweight--

Rocky: Yeah, exactly, you've got an argument there because I'm more concerned with you than I am with him. For two reasons. One for what you're talking about and the other one is to just try to explain it away if you have to.

Reno: right.

Rocky: I mean cause it's not like receiptable money, you know what I mean?

Reno: Oh yeah.

Rocky: But as far as you're concerned you just say I'm doing this job for C&L Trucking and I just assume it's there.

Reno: Right.

Rocky: I mean if it ever gets down to that, you know, just give it up and that's all you say.

Reno: Oh yeah I mean I wouldn't cut him out.

Rocky: But—

Reno: But it would just be less conspicuous if it is—

Rocky: Yeah, I know exactly, and I don't really have a problem with that. If you want to do that, that's fine with me.

Reno: It's up to you. If you want to—I mean it's your gig, so—

Rocky: You know, I need to get that up to Nashville.

Reno: Uh huh.

Rocky: You know, protected. And you're much more protection for it than he is. You know, if somebody stops him with that, holy shit.

Reno: Yeah.

Rocky: You know what I mean?

Reno: Right.

Rocky: But I don't want you having to do that long haul by yourself

Reno: Yeah. I don't want to haul by myself.

Rocky: Again, if you want to do it yourself then shit, I don't care, bring your family down. Just come straight to Miami.
