Some of the challenges I see facing the village of Shorewood in the near term are as follows:

Property taxes. There will always be a juggling act between the level of property taxes residents can afford, and the level of services the village will offer. I think the village board needs to know what services the residents need and demand, and what they are willing to pay for. The search for ways to save money while delivering good service will be a permanent, on-going process.

The cost of transportation. I think the village needs to explore all options for mass transit and rapid transit. It also needs to do as much as possible to insure that Shorewood is a place where residents can walk to local businesses. The village needs to do all that it can to foster a healthy local business community. The more goods and services that Shorewood residents can purchase locally, the better it is for all of us.

Relationships with neighboring communities. I see this as another ongoing process, in which the village of Shorewood needs to work together with the city of Milwaukee, the village of Whitefish Bay, and other neighbors on issues of public safety, transportation, and all quality of life issues. Shorewood cannot be an enclave, keeping distance from its neighbors. Its health is in some ways dependent on the health of its neighbors.
